How to ban packaged water for good.

Discourage the sale of packaged still water

Introduce a warning label for packaged water stating its negative impact on the environment and public health by the end of 2025.

Strict reduction targets

Deliver a clear phase-out plan for the production and distribution of still packaged water, incl. single-use plastic bottles, cartons and cans by 2025.

How to give access to free tap water.

Ensure access to tap water in public spaces

Invest in nationwide infrastructure for public water refill stations by 2026, to ensure the right to clean tap water is guaranteed in all public spaces, from parks to schools and train stations.

Prohibit distribution

By 2025, implement legislation banning single-use plastic bottles in public institutions and promoting the use of reusable alternative.

How to create awareness. Encourage change.

Consumer education

From 2024, launch campaigns highlighting the safety and benefits of tap water and reusable bottles. These awareness campaigns should focus on health, cost savings and environmental benefits, and engage the public in making more sustainable choices.
